

## Membership basics:

Thank you for being a valued part of The Tabernacle church family. We invite you to consider the opportunity of membership within our faith community. Membership is a vital part of participation in the church.

Membership is important for several reasons. First, only members can be eligible for formal church leadership (board, trustee, etc.). Secondly, only members can vote on the selection of our Lead Pastor and on any changes to our Constitution and Bylaws. Finally, becoming a member signifies a voluntary, but non-binding, commitment to our faith community. Please take time to look over the information provided in the following pages. The pastoral staff is available to answer any questions you might have about membership.

## FAQ's:

## Who can be a member?

-Confessed followers of Jesus Christ (only those over 16).
-Agree in principle to the Articles of Faith and Discipleship.
-Becoming a member is making a commitment to the local church body; it is not to be regarded as requirement/assurance of salvation. You can terminate your membership whenever you choose.

## What do I have to do to become a member?

-Complete the simple membership application.
-Read through our Constitution and Bylaws (can be found at thetabchurch.com)
-Write a testimony of how you came to be a follower of Christ.
-Attend MERGE, our On-Ramp to The Tabernacle and share any concerns or questions.

## Who decides who can become a member?

First, the pastoral staff team reviews the application of prospective members and submits eligible candidates to the Executive Board. Secondly, the Board votes on the candidates. The new members are acknowledged at a worship service.

## What does the Bible say about membership?

It is clear the early church kept rolls and had forms of governance implying some form of membership. However, there are no specific instructions on how churches should govern themselves. It does teach that Jesus Christ is to be the ultimate head of the church.

## What do I have to do to become a member?

-When you have completed your application, please seal it in an envelope, with a recent photo of yourself. You can also email a photo to us at buckleyoffice@thetabchurch.com
-Applications can be dropped off at THE HUB during weekend services or at The Tabernacle during office hours. (Mon.-Thur. 9am-1pm)

- Once your application is received, you will be contacted by a Tabernacle Board Member. Membership applications are reviewed during regularly scheduled Tabernacle Board Meetings.
