

Infectious Disease/COVID-19 Response Plan Staff/Leader Travel Policy Updated: March 2022

The Tabernacle is committed to the health and safety of its congregation, staff and volunteers. The infectious disease response plan outlined below addresses the current COVID-19 situation and are based on both local and state government recommendations. This plan may change based on new or updated guidelines.

- Those staff members/ministry leaders who have recently traveled are asked to self-monitor for symptoms of COVID-19 for 10 days from the date of their return.
- A mask is not required during this time but may be worn when at Tabernacle gatherings, events and/or services as additional protection if the individual has traveled to a high-risk area.
- The Tabernacle does not require a 10-day home quarantine following travel.
- If you have been exposed to or tested positive to COVID-19, please follow the guidelines outlined in *The Tabernacle Workplace Safety* policy.
- While attending Tabernacle events/services or serving in our offices/other locations, we ask that all staff members/ministry leaders engage in appropriate hygiene and safety practices which includes frequent hand washing, observing social distancing, respecting the boundaries of others and taking responsibility for their personal health.
