

## COVID-19 Response Church-wide Cleaning Guidelines Updated: March 2022

The Tabernacle is committed to the health and safety of its congregation, staff and volunteers. The infectious disease response plan outlined below addresses the current COVID-19 situation and are based on both local and state government recommendations for safely and responsibly cleaning/maintaining our Tabernacle campus properties. This plan may change based on new or updated guidelines.

Staff/ministry leaders/directors will be responsible for following/adapting/ implementing these guidelines for their specific area and communicating these guidelines to their volunteer teams.

- All high-touch surfaces that are present in the area of use, such as door handles, microphones, storage containers, toys, counters, cribs, light switches, changing tables, tables, trash cans, iPads, remotes, check-in equipment, and other items/ surfaces will be cleaned between services/events and after use. Each ministry will be responsible for creating a list of those surfaces in their areas that will require cleaning and communicating this list to their volunteer teams.
- Bathroom surfaces should be cleaned after use.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be available in all areas of use.
- Cleaning supplies will be available in all areas of use. These will be stored out-ofreach of children and used according to product guidelines for effective disinfection/cleaning.
- Staff/ministry leaders/directors will schedule a regular time to deep-clean their areas of use. This can be scheduled based on the amount of use in the specific area and at the discretion of the staff/ministry leader/director.
- Volunteers will receive training prior to serving in regard to appropriate cleaning procedures.
