

## Fire Pit Use Policy Buckley Campus Sept 2022

Tabernacle staff will follow the policies/procedures below in regard to the use of the Buckley Campus fire pit. Additional questions regarding this policy can be directed to Church-wide Facilities Manager John Williams or Buckley Campus Pastor Martin Rizzi.

The Tabernacle acknowledges that fire pits have an inherent risk of danger and individuals assume that risk upon use of the fire pit and must make every effort to practice safe behavior.

## **Usage Policy:**

- Those using the fire pit must be at least 21 years of age and approved by the facility manager or campus pastor.
- Those individuals who have been approved to use the fire pit will be in attendance at all times when it is lit and for an additional 20 minutes after it is turned off, to allow for it to cool.
- They must also review the safety and emergency procedures listed below with either the Campus Pastor or Church-wide Facilities Director.

## Safety Procedures:

- The fire pit must not be left unattended when lit.
- The fire pit must be covered when not in use.
- Please do not allow children or adults to sit, stand or climb on the fire pit
- Children must be attended by an adult at all times around the fire.
- "Horseplay," must be kept outside of the fire area.

- Do not put trash, wood or other debris into the fire pit.
- The designated fire extinguisher must be at the fire pit when it is lit. This is located under the usher counter in T2.

## In the Event of an Emergency:

- Call 911 immediately.
- Turn off "emergency shut off," located at the tank.
- Address any injuries immediately.
- Inform the Church-wide Facilities Manger and Campus Pastor as soon as possible.
- Fill out incident report.
