

Weather/Emergency Cancellation Policy Tabernacle Staff/Ministry Leaders/Volunteers Sept 2022

When Tabernacle services/events are cancelled due to emergency or inclement weather situations, an announcement will be issued through Tabernacle social media platforms. When possible, an all staff/member/volunteer/leader e-mail will be sent out for major cancellations due to weather or other building closings (due to power outages, etc.). Until an official closing announcement is issued, staff/ministry leaders/volunteers may assume that activities will continue as normal.

In addition, staff/ministry leaders/volunteers can reference the point below in regard to specific weather/emergency situations:

- When a severe weather advisory is present, staff/ministry leaders/volunteers
 will be advised to use their own judgement when driving to services/events.
 When determining whether to safely travel to work, consider how far you live
 from work, what kind of car you drive, road conditions, and/or if there is a
 school closing in your school district, etc.
- Staff/ministry leaders/volunteers are asked to not send out any information regarding closing/cancellations until they have received confirmation from their direct report.
- Re-scheduling for events and other information regarding cancellations will be determined by The Tabernacle Leadership Team and communicated to staff/ministry leaders/volunteers.
