WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

- What does the crowd's reaction to Paul reveal about the danger of religious zeal without grace?

- What does Paul's testimony teach us about how God works through personal transformation to advance His mission?

- What does this passage show us about God's purposes continuing even in chaos, misunderstanding, and opposition? Contrast human perceptions with God's Omniscience.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN FOR ME?

- Where might we be tempted to defend God or my beliefs with anger, fear, or exclusion instead of trust, humility, and grace?

- How does Paul's willingness to share his story—even in the face of hostility—challenge the way we speak about Jesus in difficult or uncomfortable settings

- What would it look like for us to trust God's purposes when obedience leads to misunderstanding or opposition rather than immediate results? Often a direct domino story!
