WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

- Jesus speaks to Paul “in the Hebrew language.” What does this detail reveal about the nature of God’s communication?

- A “goat” was used to steer an ox in the right direction. What does this metaphor suggest about Saul’s resistance? How does this apply today?

- Paul describes conversion as moving:
 - From dark to light
 - from the power of Satan to God
 - from unforgiven to forgiven
 - from outsider to sanctified.

What does this description teach us about salvation?

- In what ways has God been clearly speaking to you recently through His Word? Is there anything you’ve been resisting?

- Is there an area where “delayed obedience” has become “quiet disobedience” in your life?

- Looking at your life, what visible “fruit” shows that your faith is active and moving forward?

- If someone challenged your faith as irrational, how confident would you feel responding? What step could you take to grow in confidence?
