### WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

- If Jesus' resurrection is a real, historical victory over sin and death, how should that change the way we view fear, suffering, or even death in our own lives?
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- When Mary Magdalene recognized Jesus only after He called her by name, what does that tell us about the difference between knowing about Jesus and actually knowing Him personally?
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- Based on the Gospel of John 3:3–7, what does being “born again” practically look like in someone's life—and how is that different from just trying to be a better or more religious person?
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### WHAT DOES IT MEAN FOR ME?

- If Jesus truly rose from the dead, what area of my life (fear, doubt, control, suffering) do I need to start viewing differently in light of His victory?
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- Like Mary Magdalene, where in my life might I be missing Jesus because I'm not listening for His voice—and what would it look like for me to recognize and respond to Him personally?
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- In light of Gospel of John 3:3–7, have I experienced true spiritual rebirth, or am I relying on religion, effort, or habits—and what step is God prompting me to take toward real transformation?
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
